Encounters With Christ

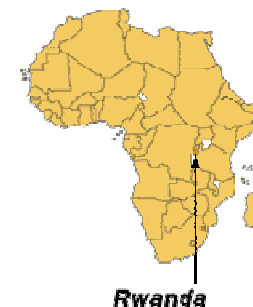
Come join us on Sunday mornings at 10:45 a.m. as Pastor Chris will finish speaking on "The Encounters with Christ" on July 18th.
